FOOD & MEDICATION

FOOD RELIEF

CalFresh is a federal program known as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) which provides monthly food benefits to low-income individuals & families. CalFresh is for people with low-income who meet federal income eligibility rules and supplements obtaining healthy and nutritious food.

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)
