Psychological challenges are a part of daily life, which can be heightened with social isolation.

According to the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), one in five American adults experiences some form of mental illness in any given year. They also report that one of every 25 adults is living with a serious mental health condition, such as schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, or long-term recurring major depression.

Treatment is important at any age and may require adding mental health professionals to your team of health providers. Your physician can advise about medication and referrals to a specialist. Contact your insurance plan for providers within your network.
